

# Western Australian Coding Rule

### 0715/02 Infected haematoma

#### Q.

How should infected haematoma of a surgical wound be coded (perianal abscess excision site)?

#### Α.

Infected haematoma of surgical wound should be coded:

T81.0 Haemorrhage and haematoma complicating a procedure, not elsewhere classified

T81.4 Wound infection following a procedure, not elsewhere classified followed by appropriate infectious agent code (if present) and external cause codes.

For infected traumatic haematomas, assign first a code for the haematoma, followed by T79.3 *Post traumatic wound infection, not elsewhere classified* along with appropriate infectious agent code (if present) and external cause codes.

#### **DECISION**

Infected haematoma of surgical wound should be coded:

T81.0 Haemorrhage and haematoma complicating a procedure, not elsewhere classified T81.4 Wound infection following a procedure, not elsewhere classified followed by appropriate infectious agent code (if present) and external cause codes.

This WA Coding Rule 0715/02 *Infected haematoma* supersedes WA Coding Rule 0911/02 *Infected haematoma*.

This advice has a minor modification to correspond with an update in ICD-10-AM/ACHI/ACS Ninth Edition.

## 0911/02 Infected haematoma

Q.

How should infected haematoma of a surgical wound be coded (perianal abscess excision site)?

Α.

Infected haematoma of surgical wound should be coded:

T81.0 Haemorrhage and haematoma complicating a procedure NEC

T81.41 Wound infection following a procedure followed by any appropriate infectious agent code (if present) and external cause codes.

For infected traumatic haematomas, assign first a code for the haematoma, followed by T79.3 *Post traumatic wound infection NEC* along with the any appropriate infectious agent code (if present) and external cause codes.

### **DECISION**

Infected haematoma of surgical wound should be coded:

T81.0 Haemorrhage ànd haematoma complicating a procedure NEC

T81.41 Wound infection following a procedure followed by appropriate external cause codes.
